In addition, we have daily cleaning procedures for all areas of River Ridge Golf Club that prioritize cleanliness and disinfection. We have implemented additional cleanliness practices as follows:

- -Disinfecting countertops, tables, chairs, and door knobs several times daily
- -Properly sanitizing steering wheels, handles, and seats of golf carts after use
- -We have removed bunker rakes from sand traps
 - → Please smooth bunkers as best as possible with your foot
- -Removed ball washers from course
- -Removed water coolers from course
 - → Cups of water are available in the snack bar
- -We recommend you leave flagsticks in the hole and play gimme putts within the leather

For the foreseeable future, our golf course and facilities will remain open. However, we will not allow dining in the snack bar, per the executive order issued by Governor Roy Cooper.

Please do your part by properly washing your hands, maintaining space between you and others visiting the club, and staying home if you are sick. This is a rapidly evolving situation, and information is subject to change as new developments occur.
